Fluoride Problem in Drinking Water

Source of Fluoride

- Drinking water having an more amount than 1.0 mg/L of water
- Black tea without milk
- Black and red rock salt
- Snacks prepared with black or red rock salt.
- Dental Products like fluoride tooth pastes and mouth rinses.
- Drug containing fluride on long time treatment for disease viz., depression, osteoporosis etc
- Tobacco or supari chewing

Symptoms of fluorosis

Dental fluorosis and skeleton fluorosis with the following sypmptoms:

- Aches and pain in joints
- Stifness in joints
- Gastrointestinal problems
- Muscle weakness
- Anemia / low hemoglobin
- Infertility
