Eligibility & Role of Students, Mentors/Advisors

To qualify for the competition, a participant must be a Student Member or Graduate Student Member of IEEE Communications Society, or form a team with either Student Members or non-student-members that is led by a Student Member. Team members do not need to be from the same country or region.

In this competition, students play the predominant roles in developing the project and in the problem solving, while higher grade senior roles, if included on a team, are considered "mentors" or "advisors." Non-student members among authors must be listed as "Advisor".
